The Arkansas Foodbank hosted 173 Mobile Distributions in 2021.

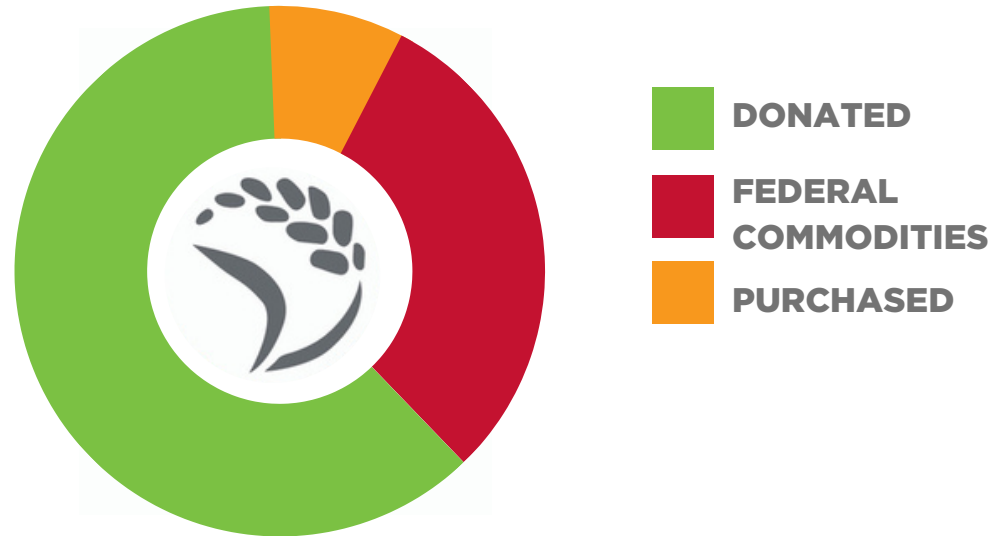

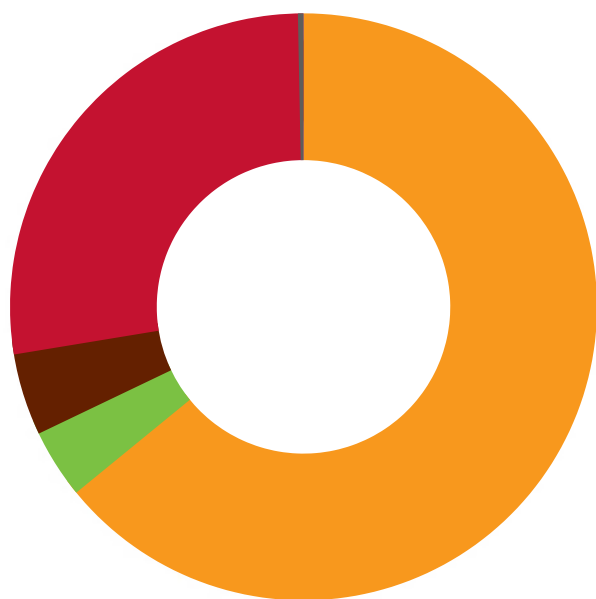

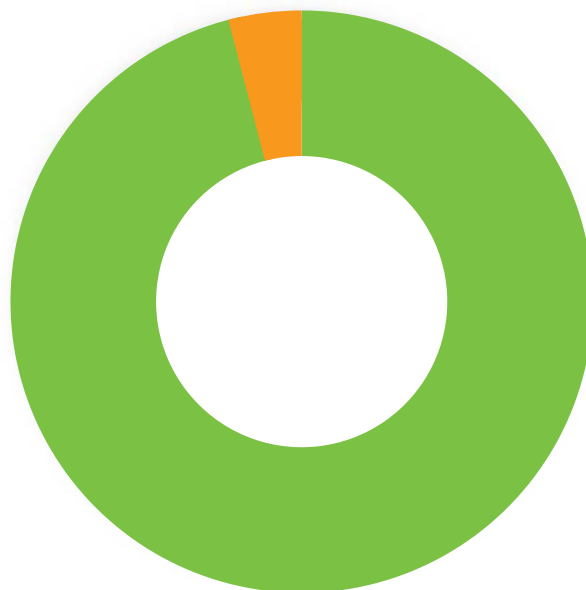
