- If you participate in work-study as a college student
- If you participate in WIC, LIHEAP, TEA, CSFP, or TEFAP
- If you are 64 years old or older
- If you care for a child under 14 years old

What to expect at your visit to a food pantry:

- You don't have to pay for food
- How often you can visit is determined by each pantry
- Some are drive-thrus and others require you to go inside
- Contact the pantry ahead of time for any questions
- You may have to fill out paperwork and show ID
- At some pantries, you may not have to show proof of income or residency
